General Guidelines for SLIC Awards

- Nominations for all awards will be sent to the vice-president and be received no later than September 30.
- All submissions will be considered by the Awards Committee whose decision will be final.
- The Awards Committee consists of the president, the treasurer and one other member of the executive.
- For all awards, both the nominator and the recipient *must* be current members of the SLIC.
- Publication, including the nomination form and the relevant information, will be provided to all SLIC members in the Zephyr newsletter and on the SLIC website.
- The nominating or selection process must be followed.
- Each award listed below consists of an engraved plaque.
- The inscription on the plaque is to be as written in the guidelines.
- Each award is to be presented by the current SLIC president or delegate at the annual conference of the SLIC.
- The background information/rationale for the award will be read aloud at the time of the presentation.
- The successful nominee will be contacted by the SLIC awards committee and will be honored at the SLIC Annual Conference.
- The documents received by the SLIC Awards Committee will become the property of the SLIC and will not be returned.

1. The Pierre & Madeleine Monod Award–French

Award


This award is presented in memory of Drs Pierre & Madeleine Monod who worked tirelessly for the promotion of excellence in teaching and support of French as a Second Language in Alberta.

Dr Pierre Monod was a professor of French at the University of Alberta and Dr Madeleine Monod was a professor of Education at the University of Alberta. They were responsible for initiating the summer program for teachers of French in Jonquière, Québec. The award consists of a plaque.

Selection Criteria

The award is presented to a member of the SLIC whose work in education and promotion of French as a Second Language (FSL) in Alberta is exceptional.

2. The Pierre & Madeleine Monod Award–International Languages

Award

This award is presented in memory of Drs Pierre & Madeleine Monod, whose work for the promotion of excellence in teaching and support of second languages in Alberta is renowned. The award consists of a plaque.

Selection Criteria

The award is presented to a member of the SLIC whose work in second language education (other than French) in Alberta is exceptional.

3. The Geneviève Balogun Multicultural Award

Award

This award is presented to highlight the multicultural aspect of the SLIC. The award consists of a plaque.

Selection Criteria

This award is presented to a member of the SLIC whose work in the area of multicultural education in Alberta is exceptional.

4. The SLIC Appreciation Plaque

Award

This award consists of a plaque with a specific message of appreciation for the work done on behalf of the SLIC.
