- -The names of the successful applicants will be posted on the SLIC webpage.
- -Bursaries can be applied toward tuition costs only. Each bursary will be paid after the SLIC Treasurer receives (a) proof of payment, (b) proof that the course took place between July 1, 2019 and July 1, 2020 and (c) proof of successful completion.
